

# OSC INITIAL COURSE APPLICATION FORM

## RYA & OSC Courses Summer 2023

Please complete page 3 of this form, selecting the course(s) on which you would like to enrol, and retain page 1 and 2 for your records. If you are proposing more than one person for courses, please photocopy page 3 (before completing) in order to retain one person only per form. A course will be set up only if there are a sufficient number of students. In case of oversubscription, priority for a place will be given to full club members for 2023. Course allocations will be dealt with in the order they are received, so apply early to increase your chance of a course place. Non-members who are given a place must take temporary membership at a cost of £30. Booking forms will be sent as soon as a course is confirmed and will include a request for payment. When this is complete, notification of a confirmed place will be sent, and this will be followed in due course by joining instructions setting out all requirements, clothing etc. **Please note, do not send payment with this application.** NOTE: The course fee will not be refunded if the applicant subsequently cancels the course unless the place can be filled, in which case an administration charge of £50 will be levied instead.

## List of Sailing Courses

### A. No RYA Certificates awarded on the following course

**Topper 1:** An introduction to sailing, fun sessions and games.  
Age limits 8 – 11. 4 x half day sessions am or pm Monday 31st July – Thursday 3rd August  
Cost £200.

**DI Course Pre-Assessment:** Preparation for DI Course. Date TBC  
Cost £50 Minimum requirements; one year AI experience, min age 16.

**Race Coaching:** Coaching for single handers on advanced racing skills, tactics and strategy.  
Cost £280 (4 days) Monday 21<sup>st</sup> – Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> August  
Min requirement: start racing qualification or substantial racing experience.

**Race Coaching for FEVAS:** Includes spinnaker use, Friday 25<sup>th</sup> August  
Cost £60 1 day Minimum requirements: RYA Spinnaker or substantial spinnaker experience, and  
Start Racing qualification or substantial Club racing experience.

### B. RYA Certificated Courses

**Racing Instructor:** To gain a Racing Instructor Qualification. Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> July  
Cost £60 1 day min Requirement: DI qualified

**Level 1 (Adult):** To learn basic skills, launch and sail, and make decisions. 29th – 30th July  
Cost £175. 2 days Age Limits: 17 - ?.

**Level 2 (Adult):** To consolidate basic skills, and gain confidence. 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Aug  
Cost £175. 2 days min requirement: Level 1 Qualification. Age Limits: 17 - ?.

**Topper 2:** Start sailing under close supervision possibly leading to a Stage 1 Certificate.  
Cost £200 4 x half day sessions am or pm Age limits 8 – 11. Mon 7<sup>th</sup> – Thur 10<sup>th</sup> August

- Topper 3** Consolidation and new skills possibly leading to a Stage 2 Certificate  
 Cost £200 2 whole days. Monday /Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> - 15<sup>th</sup> August
- Stage 1 & 2:** To learn basic skills, launch and sail.  
 Age limits 11 – 16. 5 whole days. Monday 31<sup>st</sup> July– Friday 4<sup>th</sup> August  
 Cost £350. Previous Topper courses desirable but not essential. Includes Feibusch Shield Race on Friday
- Stage 3 & 4:** Gain confidence, rig and launch unaided Monday 7<sup>th</sup> – Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> August.  
 Cost £320. 4 days Age limits 11 – 16. Min Requirement: Must have RYA Stage 2 certificate.
- Level 3 (Adult):** Consolidating skills and learning new ones. Sat & Sun 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> August  
 Cost £175 2 days Min requirement: Level 2 qualification Age limits 17 - ?
- Start Racing:** To learn knowledge and skills to participate in club racing events.  
 Age limits: none. 2 days. Monday 14<sup>th</sup> – Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> August  
 Cost £160. Under 16s must have RYA Stage 4 certificate.
- Spinnaker:** Sail effectively with a spinnaker. Mon and Wed 14<sup>th</sup> / 16<sup>th</sup> August (2 days)  
 Cost £160 Min requirements: ADULT RYA level 2; Junior RYA Stage 4  
**Course will be run using students own boats and sails. This is an essential condition.**
- Seamanship** To learn how to handle a wide range of situations afloat. Wed and Thur 16<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup> August  
 Cost £160 2 days. Must have Level 2 plus a season's sailing experience (Adults), or Stage 3 (Juniors).  
 Recommended for those hoping to enrol in a Dinghy Instructor course in the future.
- DI:** To achieve a Dinghy Instructor Rating Probably October half term  
 Cost £300 5 days  
 Min requirements; PB2 and First Aid. Satisfactory completion of DI pre-assessment course .
